General Objectives

- Develop a scope and sequence of art activities throughout the curriculum allowing for the development level of each age group.
- 2 Challenging students at all levels to explore their creative abilities.

Specific Objectives

- 1 Review the educational research on the teaching of art developmentally.
- 2. Explore new methods of art education.
- 3. Demonstrate new methods of art design, use of texture and media.
- 4. Develop procedures for evaluating products, assessing workmanship and grading students' behaviour in the art classroom.
- 5. Prepare at least two art projects for exhibit purposes, using matting or mounting techniques.
- 6. Using unit lesson planning or interdisciplinary planning, plan art activities in each subject area.
- 7. Explore the resources available in the community for the study of art.

Activities

- Research art activities appropriate for preschool, elementary, middle school, high school.
- 2. Demonstrate new methods of art expression and have the participants experiment.
- 3. Review the theories on creativity and hemisphericity (left-right brain).
- 4. Write lesson plans incorporating art activities into the subject content.

Evaluation

- 1. Art projects and lesson plans will be evaluated by the instructor.
- 2. Participants will complete a workshop evaluation form.
