General Objective

- 1. To develop a plan of action to assist teachers in the implementation of major curriculum and strategy changes in the school.
- 2. To assist teachers when the school faces a staff reduction with a reassignment of responsibilities.
- 3. To assist teachers to manage multi-grade classroom, i.e. the little one room school house.

Specific Objectives

- 1. Reviewing the procedures of textbook evaluation, selection, and implementation.
- 2. Participants will be able to design scope and sequence charts and course syllabi.
- 3. Teachers with multi-grade classrooms will review the principles of cross-age tutoring, cooperative learning, and class management for varying ages.

Activities
