General Objective

1. A content specific course to train teachers in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of secondary advanced placement courses.

Specific Objective

- 1. Develop methods of teaching advanced placement courses which may vary from other courses.
- 2. Assist teachers in personal preparation for the advanced materials covered by an AP course.
- 3. Review materials, textbooks, software, electronic books, CD ROM databases, modem applications for the AP courses.
- 4. Reviewing alternative forms of assessment, especially the introduction of writing intensive courses in content areas other than English.

Activities

- 1. Workshops designed by consultants, university personnel, and/or AP teachers.
- 2. The development of a scope and sequence/strategy plan for a specific content area.
- 3. The development of theme units, mini-units, computer courses to be used in the classroom.
- 4. Examining and evaluating the variety of textual materials, supplementary materials, audiovisuals, videos, CD ROM databases, modem application, electronic books, and laboratory settings for social studies, English, mathematics, and the sciences.
- 5. Coordinating the resources of the school media center with local university libraries and public libraries.

Evaluation

- 1. Participants write action plans for the development of their AP course. These plans will be evaluated by the consultant.
- 2. Participants will complete a workshop evaluation form.
