General Objective

1. Train participants in the use of interdisciplinary techniques in lesson planning with an emphasis on language arts programs.

Specific Objectives

- 1. Developing lesson plans using a central theme or unit idea.
- 2. Presenting the webbing techniques as an approach to lesson planning.
- 3. Explain the rationale behind the use of the interdisciplinary approach connecting language arts to science, social studies, reading, health, P.E., mathematics.
- 4. Discussing the importance of creating memorable experiences in the classroom (brain-based education).

Activities

- 1. The instructor will explain what is meant by the term "interdisciplinary language arts" and will give specific ways in which the interdisciplinary approach may be utilized.
- 2. Working in small groups, participants will design two master plans for interdisciplinary teams to fulfill subject matter requirements while organizing around a central theme.
- 3. Participants will present plans to the whole group and will evaluate offerings of the other groups.
- 4. Participants will refer to the evaluation of existing programs and will re-evaluate the programs in light of new learning acquired during the workshop.

Evaluation

- 1. The plans produced by each group will be evaluated by the instructor.
- 2. Participants will complete a workshop evaluation form.
