General Objective

1. Analyze the effectiveness of the school's present Early Childhood program and design improvement interventions for that program.

Specific Objective

- 1. Design and explain a continuum of early childhood development and the subsequent behaviors at each developmental level.
- 2. "Make and Take" workshops creating learning centers in all areas of early childhood development considering the importance of multiple intelligences.
- 3. Training participants in the teaching strategies effective with preschool children.
