General Objective

- 1. To read and discuss a book related to the field of education with other educators.
- 2. To provide all professional staff members (certified and non-certified) opportunities to engage in planned educational study and/or research which is pertinent to current innovations, issues, or problems in education.
- 3. To encourage staff members to implement "action research" within the school based on information learned from the book study.

Specific Objectives

- 1. To study an issue that is present within a school setting.
- 2. Choose an educational text that will investigate the issue chosen.
- 3. To review and discuss the issue presented in a piece of literature.
- 4. Relate the information discussed with in the school setting.

Activities

- 1. The participants will read and prepare coursework from the assigned chapters for each class session:
- 2. During each week, a different presenter will be assigned to coordinate the discussion of a chapter and work completed.
- 3. Activities will include reading materials in advance, participating in discussion, leading groups on specific topics, applying information in the classroom setting and reporting the results to the discussion group.

Evaluation

- 1. Participants will be evaluated based on attendance and preparation for class, participation in discussion, and coordination of at least one week's discussion.
- 2. Participants will complete a book study evaluation form.
