Textbook Evaluation

30 Inservice Points Component No. 4 007 001

General Objective

Provide participants with the opportunity to learn the principles involved in evaluating textbooks and to apply those principles while actually evaluating proposed textbooks.

Specific Objectives

- 1. Identify the principles to be considered in the evaluation of textbooks.
- 2. Discuss each series and produce evaluations representing the consensus of opinion of that group.
- 3. Rank order all evaluations.

Activities

- 1. The instructor will distribute a list of evaluative criteria for textbooks and will explain each.
- 2. Each participant will receive a set of proposed textbooks and ancillary materials with complete evaluations on each set by grade level.
- 3. Participants will form groups according to grade levels taught and produce a group evaluation for each series after discussing the various features of the textbooks.
- 4. Each group will rate the proposed textbooks under consideration and rank order their preferences. The final product will be submitted to the instructor.

Evaluation

- 1. The participants will submit individual evaluations of the proposed textbooks.
- 2. The participants will submit the evaluations, rank ordered, to the instructor.
- 3. Rank ordered evaluations will be discussed to determine the rationale for ranking procedures.
- 4. Participants will complete a workshop evaluation form.
