General Objectives

- 1. Development strategies in early childhood assessment (emotional, social, intellectual, and physical).
- 2. Develop assessment strategies in the early detection of at-risk children for ADD, ADHD, or SLD.
- 3. Design lesson plans which allow teachers to develop skills in interdisciplinary thematic teaching.
- 4. Assist teachers in designing lesson plans incorporating the skills of team teaching and cross-age tutoring.
- 5. Implement educational intervention plans for those children identified

Specific Objectives

- 1. Understand the interface between delayed and/or abnormal development of children ages 0-5.
- 2. Understand the various roles played by members of and interdisciplinary team in the educational and/or medical setting.
- 3. Understand a process for a sample of several team approaches.
- 4. Acquire knowledge about assessment procedures which may be used with this age group.
- 5. Develop lesson plans which incorporate the following teaching techniques: cross-age tutoring, team planning, and thematic teaching.
- 6. Be able to identify available resources and utilize strategies for consultative strategies.
