General Objectives

- 1. Utilize constructs of Executive Functioning to improve student success
- 2. Develop instructional strategies to increase student success with organizational skills, time and goal managements.
- 3. Implement a school wide program that helps develop communication, organization and long term learning strategies.

Specific Objectives

- 1. Develop age appropriate organization systems designed to improve Executive Functioning for all students
- 2. Implement classroom instructional strategies to improve project and time management.
- 3. Improve student performance through standardized instructional organizational format.
- 4. Improve student-parent-school communication through a standardized system.
- 5. Implement an organizational system in student homes to improve home school communication.
- 6. Promote faculty awareness and discussion concerning the differences between genders, the school environment and individual needs.

Activities

- 1. Workshops for faculty by RUSH institute in Chicago.
- 2. Meetings with support specialist from RUSH Institute to create filing system.
- 3. Workshops for parents concerning home school connection.
- 4. Audio-visual presentations based on gender difference in school environment
- 5. Independent reading based on gender differences.
- 6. Follow up discussion and evaluation of present system.

Evaluation

- 1. Teams will develop system for yearlong use.
- 2. Survey of systems for the school year.
- 3. Development of structure for higher level thinking skills use in executive functioning.
- 4. Meetings as divisional teams to discuss follow through on various grade levels.
