## **General Objectives**

To demonstrate, as a visiting accreditation team member basic knowledge of the process and requirements for a school to become accredited by FCIS. One accreditation team visit = 15 points (Component maxes out at 30 points (two accreditation team visits) per 5 year renewal period.)

## **Specific Objectives**

- 1. To demonstrate an awareness of the accreditation process, requirements, and procedures.
- 2. To assist in determining the objectivity and accuracy of the school's Self-Study and its reflection of the strengths and areas for improvement of the school.
- 3. To identify and demonstrate skills in classroom and facility observations.
- 4. To obtain facility in conferencing and assessment techniques.
- 5. To obtain skills in preparing written accreditation documents.

### **Activities**

- 1. Attendance a presentations/workshops presented by FCIS.
- 2. Reviewing prepared materials provided by host school.
- 3. Classroom and facility observations.
- 4. Consultation with other members of visiting team about process and requirements.
- 5. Engaging in information-gathering activities through interviews, conference, meetings, etc.
- 6. Participating in visiting committee meetings and preparation of written documents for FCIS/SACS accreditation committee and host school.

### **Evaluation**

- 1. Written contribution to the final report of the visiting team.
- 2. Completion of a brief oral or written evaluation of knowledge and experience gained from the visitation process.
- 3. Approval by committee chair.
